- Eligible participants will receive up to \$6,000 over six months, starting with \$1,500 in the first month and subsequently tapering down.
- Monthly payouts are capped at an individual's previous-drawn monthly salary.
- Once an individual successfully secures a new job, they will not be eligible for subsequent monthly payouts.
- Individuals who have received payouts will not be able to make another application within three years of their last scheme payout.




Chart 1: Maximum monthly payouts for eligible jobseekers under SkillsFuture Jobseeker Support scheme
